BOARD MEMBER SCHOOL VISITS

Trustees of the Board of Education shall have access to all schools within and special programs provided by the Yonkers City School District. Members of the Board are encouraged to visit the District's schools as a means of gaining better knowledge and understanding of the District's educational programs.

Board Members, in fulfilling their responsibilities as Trustees, have the right to visit any school within the District without prior notification. However, upon a Board Member's arrival, he/she is required to sign-in and, before having access to the building beyond the main office, the Principal or his or her designee must be informed of the visitation. At all times, the visiting Board Member shall follow all policies and procedures that relate to visitors on school property.

Concerns or opinions related to the educational program in an individual school building shall be directed to the Superintendent of Schools.
