

ENTRANCE AGE

All children who reside in the District and are of legal school age are eligible to attend school within the District. A child who is four years old on or before December first is eligible for admission to pre-kindergarten in September of that year. A child who is five years old on or before December first shall be enrolled in kindergarten in September of that year. Proof of age must be presented in the form of a birth certificate, baptismal certificate, or passport.

A child who is five years old and has regularly attended and satisfactorily completed a year's work in a kindergarten which is duly registered with the New York State Education Department will be enrolled in the first grade.

The Board authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to establish any administrative regulations and/or procedures necessary to implement and maintain this policy.
