

Overview:

This is mandated by the NYSED under the RESCUE Legislation which requires all school districts in NYS to develop comprehensive 5-Year Capital Improvement Plans every five years. This was last done in 2020. As part of the planning process and also mandated, the District must first conduct a building condition survey (BCS). Other work includes updating and auditing Facilities Schools AutoCAD Plans.

This work is fully aidable by SED at the current rate of 74%.

The proposals were evaluated by the department under qualifications-based selection methods. Responders included H2M Architects & Engineers, BBG Real Estate Services, Bureau Veritas Technical Assessments and IMEG Consultant Corp, see Summary of Proposers. Based on the review of proposals, the School Facilities Management selection committee are recommending that KG+D be awarded RFP-509 as the highest ranked proposal. KG+D is thoroughly familiar with all the aspects of the District's facilities including long term educational plans.
