This is to provide third party professional environmental engineering services for the planning and execution of the remediation stage of the "Lead in Water" abatement program. This includes the replacement or removal of deficient drinking water outlets as identified by the sampling and testing stage of the program in compliance with the "Lead Testing in School Drinking Water" legislation 10-NYCRR Subpart 67-4.

E&R was assigned by the District via Resolution 15.3 at the stated meeting on March 15, 2017 to conduct the sampling and testing stage of the program for a cost of \$20,000.00. This was completed in the spring of 2017.

Rationale: This is a new assignment for E&R under their \$ 1 million umbrella requirements Contract 619182 awarded by the Board via Res. 17.6 on January 20, 2016.

E&R's tasks will include but are not limited to creating a documented and reproducible program to remove and/or replace approximately 500 water outlets found to be "actionable" under the sampling and testing stage of the program. The newly installed outlets will be sampled and tested.

E&R will be directing Joseph Lombardo Plumbing and Heating, a licensed plumber hired by the District via Res. 17.10 dated November 15, 2017.




