This is to award contracts to 5 separate firms successful responders to RFQ313 for "Architectural & Engineering Services for the School Facilities Management Department" issued by the City Purchasing Dept. and opened on July 22, 2015.

RFQ313 was a competitive request for qualifications that had 22 responders. All responses were scored by the staff of School Facilities on a Qualifications Based Selection (QBS) basis and after interviews and other due diligence was completed the following 5 (five) firms have been selected for engagement in a twenty four month contract (with option to renew for 12 additional months):

Every project will have its own budget and schedule but will be covered by this single contract.

The \$1 million dollar price mentioned above is merely an upper limit for expenditure under this agreement and will not be encumbered. These funds, up to this limit will be encumbered and assigned to specific projects as the needs arise.

This arrangement benefits the District in that contracts for the numerous projects anticipated will not be required.
