|                  | This is to award contracts to 4 separate firms, successful responders to RFQ-460 for "On-Call" Professional Environmental Consulting Services for the School Facilities Management Department" issued by the City Purchasing Dept. and opened on April 8, 2022.   |  |  |  |
|                  | RFQ-460 was a competitive request for qualifications that had 5 responders. All responses were scored by the staff of School Facilities on a Qualifications Based Selection (QBS) basis and after interviews and other due diligence was completed the following four firms are being recommended:  |  |  |  |

WHEREAS: The District has a need for on-going professional environmental consulting services for the maintenance and improvement of its physical plant, and

WHEREAS: such services have been duly solicited in compliance with NYS Municipal Law 104B through the issuance of the publicly advertised RFQ-460 for "On-Call" Professional Environmental Consulting Services for the School Facilities Management Department, and

WHEREAS: five firms submitted proposals which were duly scrutinized and evaluated and the four firms most suited have been shortlisted and recommended for engagement:

• Adelaide Environmental Health Associates, Inc.

• H2M Architects, Engineers, Land Surveying, and Landscape Architecture, D.P.C.

• Eisenbach & Ruhnke Engineering, P.C.

• LiRo Engineers, Inc.

WHEREAS: this engagement shall be for thirty six months, with option to renew for 12 additional months at year 4 and year 5, and

WHEREAS: work under this contract shall be done on an as needed District directed basis and paid at rates negotiated on a project by project basis, and

WHEREAS: the assignments, scopes of work and fees to be paid will be subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees, and

WHEREAS: the total of the fees paid shall not exceed a total of one million dollars over the course of thirty-six months.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Superintendent of School be authorized to enter into the above contract per RFQP-460 for "On-Call" Professional Environmental Consulting Services to the listed firms for an amount \$1.0 million and a term of 3 years, renewable for 2 one year extensions.'.
