

STUDENT AUTOMOBILE AND MOTORIZED VEHICLE USE

Student driving and parking on school grounds is a privilege, not a right. Students with a valid driver's license may be eligible to drive and park on school grounds. Where available, sections of the school parking lot(s) are allotted to such students. Automobiles, motor scooters, mini-bikes, go-cars and other motorized vehicles will not be permitted to operate on school grounds without the prior approval of the Building Principal.

Students are expected to observe all driving and/or parking regulations and operate all motorized vehicles in a safe and reasonable manner. Loitering and congregating in cars and/or parking lots, reckless, unsafe, or inappropriate use of any vehicle, and/or misuse of driving/parking privileges will not be tolerated. Failure to comply with this policy and/or any rules established by the Superintendent and/or his designee and/or the Building Principal may result in a termination of parking privileges and/or discipline in accordance with the District's Code of Conduct.

While on school property, student vehicles may be subject to search if there is reasonable suspicion that drugs, alcohol, weapons, and/or any other item prohibited by District policy are contained within the vehicle.

The District shall not be responsible for any damage, including, but not limited to, theft or vandalism, to any vehicle on school grounds.

The Superintendent of Schools shall be authorized to establish any regulations, procedures, and/or protocols necessary to implement this policy.
