

BOARD MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS

The qualifications of a candidate for the office of member of the Yonkers City School District Board of Education are that the candidate be:

1. able to read and write;
2. a citizen of the United States;
3. qualified to register for or vote at an election within the City School District; and
4. a resident of the City School District for at least three years immediately preceding the date of the appointment.

In addition to the above requirements, Board members must also complete mandatory training as required by New York State Education Law.

Not more than one member of a family shall be a member of the Board. Additionally, no employee of the District may be a member of the Board, except as permitted by law.
