BOARD OFFICERS

The officers of the Board of Education shall be the President and Vice- President.

Election of Officers

The President and Vice President shall be elected from the members of the Board of Education by a roll call vote at the Board's annual organizational meeting held on the second Tuesday in May. The officers shall each receive the votes of a majority of the full membership of the Board before being declared elected.

Duties of the President of the Board

The President shall be the presiding officer of the Board. The duties of the President shall include: exercising general supervision over all matters related to the affairs of the Board; presiding at all meetings of the Board; and executing all contracts and/or documents on behalf of the Board. Additionally, the President shall be a member ex-officio of all committees and shall appoint special committees unless the Board shall otherwise order.

Duties of the Vice-President

The Vice-President, in the absence or disability of the President, shall perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President. Additionally, in the case of vacancy in the office of President, the Vice-President shall act as President until a new President shall be elected.

<u>Unexpired Term Fulfillment</u>

In the event of a vacancy in the office of President or Vice-President, the Board of Education shall, as soon as practicable, but no more than sixty (60) days following the vacancy, elect a successor to for the remainder of the term of the office.
