If you are contacted by NYSED with any questions about your agency's M/WBE plan or documentation, and/or FS10 budget/budget narrative please be sure to respond promptly to avoid or minimize delay in finalizing your award.

You will receive a final approval notice from our Grants Finance Unit when your award is approved. *No work should be initiated until you receive final notice of approval of your award. All grants, regardless of type or dollar amount, are subject to further review, monitoring, and audit to ensure compliance. SED has the right to recoup funds if the approved activities are not performed and/or the funds are expended inappropriately.*

The grant resulting from this award will require that grantees accept electronic payments for amounts due on the contract. Additional information and authorization forms are available at the State Comptroller's website at www.osc.state.ny.us/epay/index.htm.
