ABATEMENT & REPAIR OF DAMAGED LIBRARY WALL BOARD

This was inadvertently omitted from submission in January. All work is complete. Total cost is \$64,405.25 in capital bond funds.

On the afternoon of January 9, 2019 it was discovered that maintenance work had disturbed the gypsum wall board compound in the school library which was determined to be an asbestos containing building material. Air sampling confirmed that there was no release into the air but bulk sampling confirmed that the area had to be cleaned using abatement protocols. Once this was discovered the library was closed to everyone except authorized personnel required to assess the situation and plan remedial actions.

E&R Engineering, an environmental engineering firm under contract with the District responded immediately and prepared design documents, filings with the NYS Department of Labor, monitored the construction work, conducted sampling & testing and cleared the site for re-occupation. The cost of theis work is \$16,481.25.00.

The clean-up work was completed by Midlantic Environmental, Inc., at a cost of \$47,924.00 over the 3 day Martin Luther King Jr. holiday weekend while the building was unoccupied. The library was reopened on January 22, 2018 with clean air testing results.
