

PERFORMANCE BASED CONTRACT GUIDELINES

A Literacy Expert from Teaching Matters, Inc. will provide onsite support coaching Barack Obama School for Social Justice, and School 25 teachers to build effective, rigorous practices into lessons, with the goal of improving outcomes for students. To achieve this goal, the coach will support:

- Teachers to establish methods and instructional practices that create curriculum cohesion for ELA instruction.
- Students to experience and be exposed to increased academic rigor, elevating their academic expectations.
- Teachers to build an operational understanding of Culturally Responsive and Sustaining Education principles that align with ELA instruction.

The Literacy Expert from Teaching Matters will also provide district support.

2. AMOUNT OF SERVICE?

Teaching Matters proposes 20 days of onsite literacy coaching at Barack Obama School for Social Justice, and 20 days at School 25. This service will be provided at a daily rate of \$1,400. The total cost for the 85 days of support is \$56,000.

Teaching Matters is a professional learning organization that provides coaching support to teachers and school leaders. The work we propose will support staff - specifically, we will provide direct support to classroom teachers/teaching teams and provide district support.

Teaching Matters begins its work at a school with a needs assessment, resulting in an action plan. The specific goals and desired outcomes are established in collaboration with school leadership and/or the district and progress toward meeting the goals is central to the debrief conversations. Throughout the project, the assigned coach will send visit summaries to school leadership to update on progress. The coach will provide comprehensive reports of all outcomes assessment results to school leadership.

Teaching Matters sends a quarterly survey to the teachers and school leaders with whom we work for comments about the service including opportunities for constructive feedback. In addition, our work will include pre and post-cycle assessments of student work and evidence of academic improvements
