Bids were opened on November 22, 2019. There were five bidders total. Luzon is the lowest at \$131,532.85, which is considerably lower than the next lowest bidder, AARCO Environmental at \$236,233.85 is. This disparity is to be considered for future bids documents but the fact that LUZON has won this bid thrice before and has performed acceptably it is recommended that they be awarded this work again. This winning bid is \$10,525.00 more then the last time it was bid in 2016.

Rationale:

This is to award a general fund contract to the above vendor to provide testing and maintenance of the fuel oil storage tanks throughout the District in compliance with NYS Law and as mandated by the Westchester County Dept. of Health.
