Via Resolution 17.5 at their stated meeting on January 20, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded a requirements contract to Greenman Pedersen, Inc. (GPI) for an amount not to exceed \$1 million. This resolution is to assign the following specific capital work under that contract.

Via Resolution 19.14 at their stated meeting on May 18, 2016 the Board of Trustees authorized the assignment of the above subject task to GPI.

This resolution is to authorize the amendment of the fee for that task to correct mathematical errors in GPI's original proposal. This was agreed to in July of 2016 but the resolution and was inadvertently omitted from submission to the Board agendas in the interim.

Rationale:

GPI's original proposal was demonstrated not have included standard multipliers and a prescribed roofing consultant fee. Once these errors were shown clearly and the final negotiations completed the revised proposed price remained the substantially lower than all other proposers.

Most of the tasks assigned to GPI are completed and the construction is nearing completion as well. Closeout paperwork will continue until the end of calendar year 2019, a year longer later than anticipated in the original RFP.

This project includes but is not limited to building improvements such as: new roof, replace all windows and exterior doors, install new high tech security, select sidewalk, site fencing and interior finishes reconstruction. Project cost is roughly \$4.5 million.

A change order is a written agreement between the District and its contractor to change a building construction contract. They add to, delete from, or otherwise alter the work and/or progress schedule in the contract bid documents. CO's are caused by any of three situations that can arise on a project: unforeseen conditions, design errors and omissions and owner directed extra work.

This Change Order is required for design errors, unforseen conditions and owner directed extra work.

Rationale:

Item 6-CR2 is considered to be a design error. Engineer assumed storm drainage existed when it did not. Added storm drainage work to compensate for this oversight is to cost to the District \$15,317.00.

Items D & F are considered to be as a result of a discovered unforseen conditions of cracked storm drain piping concealed behind chase walls and ceiling.

Item E is considered owner directed extra work is to repair a cracked sanitary line in a classroom discovered after bid.

The total value of all extra work is in the amount of \$26,439.26 less the allowance of \$10,000.00 a balance a change order of \$16,439.26 is required.

Bids were examined and all due diligence observed in determining the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

A total of 4 bids were received with the highest bid at \$1,945,710 and average bid of \$1,756,927. The work was designed by Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. who estimated Contract 3 work be \$2.5 Million.

After interviewing the apparent low bidder and confirming that they understood the scope of work, bids were found to be correct, and the work history with the District, GPI, Savin Engineers and School Facilities Management are recommending award of this project to Rationale: Arrow Steel Window Corp. for the amount of \$1,660,000.

This resolution is to grant the administration the authority to enter into contract as described above. In compliance with General Municipal Law 103, bids were let and opened in public March 13, 2019. Bids were examined and all due diligence observed in determining the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

A total of 3 bids were received with the highest bid at \$654,047 and average bid of \$505,826. The work was designed by Greenman-Pedersen, Inc. who estimated Contract 3 work be \$386,100.

The first low bidder Hi-Tech Air Conditioning was deemed nonresponsive by City of Yonkers Purchasing Department. After interviewing the second low bidder and confirming that they understood the scope of work, bids were found to be correct and have performed acceptably on YPS projects, the YPS, Engineer, Construction Manager and Schools Facilities Management are recommending award of this project to Mengler Mechanical, Inc. for the amount of \$537,700.00, including bid Alternate 1.

Rationale: Mengler Mechanical, Inc. originally submitted a bid in the amount of \$566,000.00 (including Alternate 1) and were able to offer a

concession for the HVAC Contract bid, reducing their bid (including

Alternate 1) to \$537,700.00.
