OVERVIEW

Empowering Creative Minds LLC is pleased to submit this proposal for services to support Yonkers Public Schools in achieving its goals to develop building capacity and sustainability of the Smart Scholars Program at Roosevelt High School – Early College Studies (RHS-ECS) by providing professional learning and coaching sessions to instructional leaders and administrators. Empowering Creative Minds LLC has 15 years of experience in teaching World Languages, 6 years teaching at the university level, and its founder has facilitated workshops for teachers and administrators in the district for the past 8 years.

The Objective

Empowering Creative Minds LLC will create a series of professional learning and coaching sessions based upon RHS-ECS' goals for the 2024 – 2025 academic year:

The Opportunity

The professional learning and coaching sessions are proactive steps in building the capacity and sustainability of the Smart Scholars Program. Building capacity helps to minimize dependency on one staff member or outside experts as sources of knowledge and expertise thereby allowing RHS-ECS educators to gradually assume more responsibility as leaders. Coaching sessions will serve the same purpose of supporting the team tasked with enhancing the social media presence of the program; and the administrators and instructional leaders responsible for observing and supporting teachers to further develop their pedagogy. Lastly, professional learning sessions are important to enhance pedagogy so that learners are performing at grade level and ready to participate in rigorous high school and collegiate courses, which are an inherent component of the Smart Scholars Program.

Empowering Creative Minds LLC's goals associated with this proposal include the following:

- Goal #1: Create professional learning and coaching sessions within the identified timeline.
- Goal #2: Provide coaching sessions for the enhancement of RHS-ECS' social media presence.
- Goal #3: Design professional learning sessions for administrators and instructional leaders.
- Goal #4: Provide coaching sessions to administrators and instructional leaders.

Rationale

RHS-ECS, formerly the Early College High School, was initially granted funding for the Smart Scholars Early College High School Program (Cohort 3) in 2010. Through the Smart Scholars Early College High School Program,

...institutions of higher education (IHEs) partner with public school districts to create early college high schools that provide students with the opportunity and preparation to accelerate the completion of their high school studies while earning a minimum of twenty-four but up to sixty transferable college credits at the same time. (New York State Education Department, n.d.)

This program targets traditionally underrepresented students in postsecondary education. Students receive additional academic support from the school/college partnerships to ensure they perform at grade level and are ready to participate in rigorous high school and collegiate courses. This "dual or concurrent enrollment" program aims to increase high school graduation and college



completion rates while reducing student tuition costs because of less time required to complete a college degree (New York State Education Department, n.d.).

Although internal resources have been relied on to fulfill professional development and mentoring requirements, a need has been identified to build additional capacity among staff to ensure the sustainability of continuous improvement through professional learning and coaching sessions. In addition, the administrative team has identified (based on data) the need for professional learning sessions to further enhance teacher pedagogy aligned with RHS-ECS' and district's goals outlined in its three-year strategic plan and district foci.

Coaching is an essential component of a professional development program. In addition to enhancing skills, knowledge, and capacity, coaching creates relationships with educators that allow educators to feel supported and willing to take risks to improve their practices (Aguilar, n.d.).

Professional learning is an inherent part of a district or school's strategy to continuously strengthen educators' best practices by allowing educators to stay up to date with trends while keeping them engaged in an ever-changing educational environment. These sessions are designed to allow collaboration among participants, are linked to specific content and standards, incorporate active learning and coaching, provide models and examples, are sustained and continuous; and are aligned to school and/or district goals, standards, assessments, and other professional learning activities (Archibald, Coggshall, Croft, & Goe, 2011; Darling-Hammond, Hyler, & Gardner, 2017; Labone, & Long, 2016). Customized workshops provide staff with tools that empower them to work collaboratively, acquire and apply new skills, promote student achievement, and cultivate the talents of teachers who aspire to become educational leaders.

Execution Strategy

Our execution strategy incorporates proven pedagogy, extremely qualified personnel, and a highly responsive approach to managing deliverables. A description of our project methods, including how the project will be developed, and a proposed timeline of events are presented in the ensuing sections.

Project Approach

Dr. Ida M. D'Ugo, founder of Empowering Creative Minds LLC, will manage the project. Outlined below are a series of steps associated with the project approach:

- 1) During a meeting held on August 27, 2024, with Ms. Rexha, Dr. Rodriguez, and Mr. Mack, goals and instructional foci were shared for the 2024 2025 academic year.

- 3) Once approved, the timeline for execution will be initiated. Ms. Judon will also advise Dr. D'Ugo if any additional documentation is required by Yonkers Public Schools prior to commencing the design of the professional learning and coaching sessions.



4) Ms. Judon will be provided weekly updates via phone (or video conference) and e-mail.

EXPECTED RESULTS

Empowering Creative Minds LLC's proposal for Yonkers Public Schools provides a series of professional learning and coaching sessions for teachers and administrators.
