Additionally, one or more eight-week workshops will be conducted, including programs such as Credible Messenger Mentorship, One Step Ahead, D.R.I.L.L. TALK, and Voices to be Heard. These workshops are designed to empower participants and strengthen their personal growth. Centers on a new cohort of five students identified by the district. During this phase, 914United will conduct intake interviews with selected participants to assess their interest, readiness, and individual abilities. Participants will then engage in small group sessions with mentors, where they will learn to develop actionable service plans with clear, achievable (SMART) goals. These plans will be crafted with the guidance and expertise of the mentors, who will meet weekly with each participant to review progress, provide personalized support, and adjust goals as necessary. In addition to ongoing mentorship, one or more eight-week workshops will be conducted, featuring programs such as Credible Messenger Mentorship, One Step Ahead, D.R.I.L.L. TALK, and Voices to be Heard, all aimed at fostering growth, leadership, and self-awareness. Group orientation sessions and individual intake interviews will also take place, ensuring each participant's unique needs and abilities are carefully evaluated. Furthermore, during this quarter, the progress of Quarter One participants will be monitored through check-ins to ensure continuous support, assess growth, and make any necessary adjustments to their service plans.	914United Site	\$ 83.33	60	2	\$5,000
Focuses on a new cohort of five students or a blend of students from Quarter One and Quarter Two, selected based on mutual agreement between the district and 914United, identifying those who would benefit from continued participation. Mentors will meet with participants on a weekly basis to review the progress of their service plans, provide targeted guidance, and adjust strategies as needed to ensure goals remain attainable and relevant. Throughout this quarter, participants will engage in one or more eight-week workshops, including Credible Messenger Mentorship, One Step Ahead, D.R.I.L.L. TALK, and Voices to be Heard, which are designed to further their development and enhance critical life skills. Additionally, group orientation sessions and individual intake interviews will be conducted as needed to assess each participant's ongoing interest, needs, and abilities. Mentors will also assess each participant's readiness for employment or further program involvement, ensuring they are on track to meet both short-term and long-term objectives.
