Rationale:

Ultimate Power, Inc. Term: 365 calendar days Amount: \$785,000.00

Scope: To authorize the award of a general fund service contract for

"Service and Repair of Burners and Boilers".

Overview:

In compliance with General Municipal Law 103, bids were let and opened in public on March 15, 2024. Five (5) bids were received. The apparent first low bidder, Best Climate Control Corp., was deemed non-responsive due to an incomplete bid submission. The second low bidder was Ultimate Power, Inc. with a bid of \$785,000.00. The bids were duly examined and all due diligence observed in determining that Ultimate Power, Inc. is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The highest bid was \$1,520,000.00.

This is the annual service contract, with the provision for renewal up to four additional years by mutual consent under the same terms and conditions for the preventative maintenance, cleaning, inspection and repair of the boilers and burners in the District.

Ultimate Power has won this contract in the past through competitive bidding and has performed acceptably.
